4. To prepare participants to support teenagers in building relationships, coping with bullying, and building career possibilities.



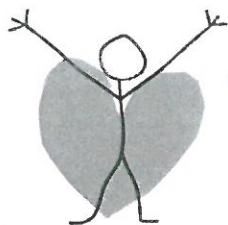
