### **ACADEMIC AWARD**

To recognise students who, in their time at the school, have displayed academic qualities and achievements based on a range of intelligences. School data of PAT Testing, NAPLAN testing, and School Reports are consulted in the selection of students.

In the selection of students to receive the award the following should be considered:

- o Classroom work demonstrating academic excellence
- o Results from standardised testing and school reports
- Consistent demonstration of high level of learning and achievement across all key areas

### **ARTS AWARD**

To recognise students who, in their time at the school, have made a significant and positive contribution to The Arts (visual arts, music, dance, media art, and drama). Class Teachers and Arts Specialist Teachers are consulted for the selection of students.

In the selection of students to receive the award the following should be considered:

- Academic excellence across The Arts learning area visual arts, dance, media art, and drama
- Skills and knowledge necessary to express ideas and communicate through The Arts

## SPORTSPERSONSHIP AWARD

To recognise students who, in their time at the school, have exhibited qualities desirable for positive participation in sport. Class Teachers and Physical Education Teacher(s) are consulted in the selection of students.

In the selection of students to receive the award the following should be considered:

The consistent demonstration of -

- A positive sporting attitude and sense of fair play
- Leadership in sporting endeavours
- Skills and knowledge of sports in which they have successfully participated

#### CITIZENSHIP AWARD

To recognise students who, in their time at the school, have demonstrated the qualities of the educational legacy of Mary Mackillop, founder of the Sisters of St Joseph. All staff are consulted for the selection of students.

In the selection of students to receive the award the following should be considered. The student needs to have consistently, in their time at STM, demonstrated the Gospel values, as outlined in the school mission statement:

- Respect
- Integrity
- Dignity
